This painting is the last from a show painted in 2018. It was a challenge to myself to take two circles at opposite sides and unite them using personal imagery. It was a challenge because abstract painters always risk unwittingly *making a face*.

Using random pours and decalcomania inspired by Max Ernst (and memories of a trip to the Museum of Miro in Barcelona) I added personal imagery of the path and the tilted ellipse. In the process the painting developed an animus and said Hello Is It me You're Looking For.

It doesn't do to be too cerebral about abstract painting as sometimes feelings take over. This painting reminds me of the first time I saw my baby's face.
