

<u>Simplexity</u> is a solo abstract exhibition by emerging artist Sarah L Stewart. Using process based techniques she constructs a pictorial world that sits softly in space, rectilinear forms shuffling and bumping together, emerging from the imaginary landscape with drips still apparent and edges blurred. She describes her process;

> I add layer upon layer, often removing as much paint as I apply, so that each 'finished' painting has several underpaintings lurking beneath the surface, creating a history for each work.

Like life, history informs action and each subsequent mark builds on its underlayers, calling on the artist to tweak the composition in what abstract painting guru Hans Hoffman referred to as *the push and pull of abstract art*. This is done effort-lessly using sophisticated colour and elegant tonal passages that take the viewer on a journey through the artist's memories of landscape, encounter and the body.
